Description of Palliative Services

Colorado Palliative & Hospice Care's palliative program provides individualized care for seniors with serious illnesses, who are experiencing some or all of the following:



- ◆ **Seeking** relief from severe chronic illnesses with symptoms such as pain, shortness of air and anxiety.
- ◆ **Needing** complex care, as the result of multiple diseases, requiring difficult and complex decisions to be made
- ◆ **Requiring** many medications for disease and symptom control
- ◆ **Suffering** from low quality of life for both the patient and the family
- ◆ **Receiving** care from multiple health care professionals
- ◆ **Experiencing** frequent health care episodes resulting in emergency hospitalizations or additional treatment
- ◆ **Obtaining** curative treatment but also needing additional assistance

Medical Director

- ◆ Pain Management Consultation
- ◆ Palliative Care Consultant
- ◆ Works with Your Primary Care Physician
- ◆ Palliative Team Oversight

Social Services

- ◆ Family/Patient Counseling
- ◆ Assists with End-of-Life Planning Including DNRs, Funeral Preparations and Advanced Directives
- ◆ Identification of Available Community Resources

Spiritual Counselors/Chaplains

- ◆ Family/Patient Counseling and Spiritual Support
- ◆ Conducting Memorial Services
- ◆ Bereavement Counseling

Clinical Director

- ◆ Oversees Implementation, Delivery, and Coordination of Care
- ◆ Supervises Services Provided by the Team

RN Case Manager

- ◆ Coordinates Patient Care
- ◆ Medication Oversight
- ◆ Physician Liaison
- ◆ Reviews Treatment Options and Makes Recommendations

RN/LPNs

- ◆ Direct Nursing Care
- ◆ Monitors Care and Comfort in the Home/Facility
- ◆ Educates in the Home
- ◆ 24-hour / 7-day a Week Availability
